Stauder wins \$15M Navy order

Stauder Technologies earned a nearly \$15 million contract from the U.S. Navy, the U.S. Department of Defense said Tuesday.

Stauder provides custom software for the commercial and military markets.

The order, a modification under a previously awarded contract, is for 448 man-portable equipment suites known as Target Location, Designation and Hand-off Systems (TLDHS). The hand-held computer system enables the user to acquire targets then transmit, or hand off, target data to agencies providing supporting fire, using current and planned communications equipment.

Work will be performed in St. Peters, where Stauder is based, and is expected to be completed by April 2008.
